| Crown | vase-shaped, dark, dense crown |
| Bark and branches | brown, grey |
| Leaf | green, bluegreen |
| Flowers | yellow, flowers in March |
| Fruits | black |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil |
| Paving | tolerates no paving |
| Winter hardness zone | 7a (-17,7 to -15,0 °C) |
| Wind resistance | moderate |
| Fauna tree | attractive for bees (honey plant) |
| Application | tree containers, roof gardens, coastal areas, small gardens, patio gardens |
