



## Quercus ilicifolia



<b>Height</b>	6-8 m
<b>Width</b>	6-8m
<b>Crown</b>	flatened spherical, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown, grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Autumn colour</b>	red
<b>Flowers</b>	greenyellow, red, flowers in May
<b>Fruits</b>	brown, black
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), provides food for birds
<b>Application</b>	industrial areas
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree
